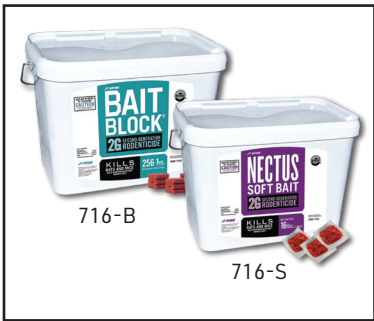

FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Store your bait away from other pesticides & chemical odors.
- Place in tamper-resistant bait stations.
 - 15-30' apart for rats
 - 8-16' apart for mice
- Wear waterproof gloves when handling bait.
- Always place along walls where rodents run.
- Keep out of reach of children & pets.
- Read the label.
- Check state laws for current regulations.

TYPES OF BAIT:



2G Bait

- Blocks or Soft Bait that lure rats & mice.
- Active ingredient is bromadiolone.
- Blocks are formulated for humid conditions.
- Soft bait lures rodents where water is not available.
- Highly palatable compounds.
- Professional use only.



Top Gun

- Blocks or Pellets that lure mice & rats.
- Active ingredient is bromethalin.
- Only one feeding needed to cause mortality.



Bait Blocks

- Paraffin blocks that lure rats & mice.
- Active ingredient is diphacinone.
- Center holes for use in bait stations.



Bait Blocks for Rodents & Ticks

- Kills rodents & blacklegged ticks.
- Active ingredients warfarin & fipronil.
